

Changing Your Child's Name and Gender

Note: Use these instructions and forms to change your child's legal name and gender.

These instructions and forms may not be right for your case. They can't take the place of advice from a lawyer. Talk to a lawyer if you have **any** questions.

Do not change these forms. If you change the forms, you might lose language you need.

If you are seeking a name change only, please contact Montana Legal Services Association at <u>www.mtlsa.org</u> or 1-800-666-6899.

What Forms Will I Need to Change My Child's Name and Gender?

One of the child's parents will need to fill out and file these forms. If both of the child's parents are dead, the child's guardian may fill out these forms.

- Petition for Change of Name and Gender (Minor)
- Affidavit of Parent/Guardian in Support of Petition for Name and Gender Change of Minor Child
- Order Setting Hearing (only if one parent doesn't agree to the change)
- Order Granting Petition for Change of Name and Gender
- Statement of Inability to Pay (only if you cannot afford filing fees)

The **Petition** asks the court to change the child's name and gender. It also asks that the court waives the requirement to publish information about the child's name and gender change so they are not "outed" and their safety put at risk.

The Affidavit of Parent/Guardian in Support of Petition for Change of Name and Gender

tells the court that the parents agree that the child's name and gender should be changed. Both "Changing Your Name and Gender (for Minors)," ©2020 Montana Legal Services Association. Use of this form is restricted to not-for-profit purposes. Last updated 12/4/20. of the child's parents should fill out one of these forms. If the child has any legal guardians, the legal guardians will need to fill out this form too.

The **Order Setting Hearing** will be filled out by the judge and will tell you when and where your hearing will be held. The judge will schedule a hearing if the other parent doesn't agree to the name and gender change of their minor child.

The **Order Granting Petition for Name and Gender Change** will be filled out by the judge. The Order will legally change the child's name and gender and may order changes to the child's birth records.

The **Statement of Inability to Pay** asks the court to waive the filing fees in your case. If you can't afford to pay the filing fees, ask your clerk of district court for an affidavit of inability to pay. This form may be called something else in your district.

A **sealed record** means that all court papers relating to your legal name and gender change will be kept from the public. The court will keep your papers in a file and will not let anyone else see them.



What Words Do I Need to Know?

Minor Child - A minor child is a person who is under 18 years old.

Petitioner - A Petitioner is someone who files an action in court. If you are asking the Court to change your child's name and gender, you are the Petitioner.

Who Can Use the Form?

You can use these forms if:

- You want to change your child's legal name and gender;
- The child is under 18 years old;
- You are one of the child's parents. Or, if both of the child's parents are dead, you are the child's guardian;
- Both of the parents and any legal guardians of the child agree to the name change.

• You are not changing your name in order to avoid debt, hide a criminal record, or for any other improper reason.

Note: You can only use these forms if both parents and any legal guardians agree to the child's name and gender change. If the parents or legal guardians disagree about the name change, you will need to talk to a lawyer.

What Do I Do with the Forms?

- 1 Fill out the Forms
 - Fill out all the blanks on the Petition for Change of Name and Gender (Minor)
 - Sign and date your Petition for Change of Name and Gender (Minor).

Have both of the child's parents fill out and sign an Affidavit in Support of Petition for Change of Name and Gender. The forms must be signed in front of a Notary Public. If the child has any legal guardians, the legal guardians must also sign a Consent form.



If the other parent does not consent or agree to changing your child's name, then you may have to file additional documents to serve the other parent. Contact your local clerk of court for more information.

Fill out the judicial district, county, and caption on all of the other forms (Order Setting Hearing, Notice of Hearing on Change of Name and Gender of a Minor Child, and the Order Granting Petition for Change of Name and Gender). The caption looks like this:

2 Make Copies

Make one copy of each form after you have filled them out.

3 File Forms at the Courthouse

Go to the Clerk of District Court's office in your county courthouse. File the original Petition for Change of Name and Gender (Minor), Consent to Change of Name and Gender of Minor Child, and Order Setting Hearing.



- If you can't afford the filing fees, ask the Clerk of District Court for the Statement of Inability to Pay. This form may be called something different in your county.
- Give your copies to the Clerk of District Court and ask them to stamp the copies as "Filed". Keep the copies in a safe place.

4 Fill out Your Order Granting Change of Name and Gender

- - We've included three (3) different orders in this packet. The order that you fill out depends on where you were born. If you were born in Montana, please fill out the first order. If you were born in Texas, please fill out the second order. And, if you were born in another state that isn't Texas or Montana, fill out the last order provided.

- Fill in all of the blanks that you can on the Order Granting Petition for Change of Name and Gender. If the judge changes the child's name, they will sign the Order after your hearing.
- Make one copy of your filled Order Granting Petition for Change of Name and Gender, and keep it with the rest of your court forms.

5 Go to Your Hearing

- Bring your stamped copies of the documents you filed with the court. Also bring your original and copy of the Order Granting Petition for Change of Name and Gender.
- Bring the minor child with you to the hearing, the judge may ask the child some questions.
- Arrive at the courthouse at least 15 minutes before your scheduled hearing. Dress like you were going to an important job interview.
- Check with the Clerk of Court's office to find the right courtroom for your hearing.
 Go to that courtroom and wait for the judge to call your name and case number.
 Remember to address the judge as "Your Honor".
- Be prepared to tell the judge why you want to change your child's name and gender.
- Important: Immediately after your hearing, take your signed Order Granting Petition for Change of Name and Gender to the Clerk of District Court. You may want to ask the Clerk for several certified copies of the order. You will need the certified copies to get a new driver's license, birth certificate, and social security card for your child.

1	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
2	
3	1. This Court has jurisdiction over the minor child.
4	2. The minor child has a valid medical reason for the requested name and gender
5	change, it is not for the purpose of hiding a criminal record, avoiding a debt, or
6	for any improper purpose.
7	3. Publication should be waived because probable cause exists to believe that
8 9	publication or notice would expose the minor child to unnecessary risk of
10	abuse.
11	4. Publication and notice are not required.
12	5. This Court has authority to change the minor child's name (Mont. Code Ann.
13	Title 27, Chapter 31).
14 15	6. This Court has authority to recognize and order a change to gender listed on
16	the minor child's Montana birth certificate. Admin R. Mont. 37.8.311(5)(c).
